By Car – there is limited street parking.

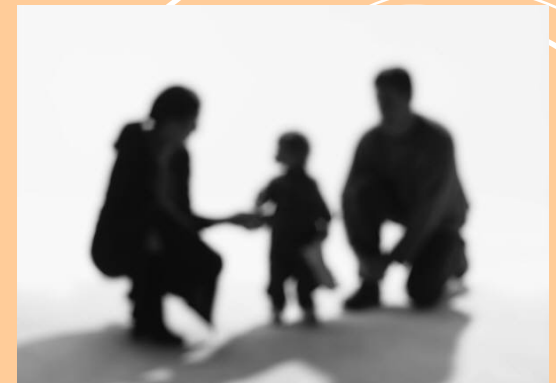
The workshop will be held in the Main Conference Room on the main floor to the right of the Atlantic Ave. entrance.
